Client Profile

- Political Party based out at Botswana

Business Need

- Client is looking to re-brand the look and feel of existing website. Also wanted to provide online donation functionality by integrating payment gateway with internet Public Facing Website for client on office 365 SharePoint Online 2013.

Challenges

- Creating a Photoshop design of Home Page and Sub-pages.
- Creating HTML pages from design using HTML 5, jQuery and CSS.
- Design custom master Page, Page layouts.
- Provide Payment Gateway functionality.
- Use Sandbox solution for custom web parts.
- Activate/de-activate features for the Public-facing site collection or its sub-sites from the UI.
- Customize the "Promoted Links" web part design.
- Image slider in header and footer using jQuery.
- Custom modal dialog with content using jQuery.
- Provide "Download a Copy" OOB feature on custom links.

Benefits

- Custom web part that allows managing activate/de-activate features from the UI.
- Payments Gateway integration using JavaScript.

Technology

- Office 365SharePoint Online 2013
- SharePoint Designer 2013

Payment Process Flow

Following is payment process flow:

- A nonparty member fills in the registration form.
- He / She pay for the registration.
- After payment, a membership number and a receipt number is returned back to the user.
- The political party office will then receive notification of the registration, and start creating a membership card for the user. So, without payment, the nonparty member will not be enrolled in the party membership system. Non member will not be allowed to vote. So, it's very important that the user pays for the membership.
- There a two types of memberships. Depending on the type of membership a user has selected, we then pass the relevant value to payment gateway page:
- Membership Types are:
 - Annual: \$10.00
 - Life Time: \$ 100.00
- When a user clicks on the "continue" button, we pass parameters to the payment gateway page.
